



Pupil Premium Report - 14-15

Rivers Academy, West London received a total of **£373,298.75** for the period September 2014-August 2015 as a direct grant from the Department for Education.

During this year, approximately 42% of students at the academy were counted as attracting Pupil Premium Grant funding, meaning that they are either currently receiving Free School Meals or that at some point in the past 6 years they have been in receipt of these.
